Eligibility

To qualify for our services, you must earn below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines as established by the HHS. Controversy cases taken on by the clinic will ensure that the amount of the controversy for a taxable year will not exceed the amount specified by the IRS, currently \$50,000.

There is never a fee charged for our services*. ***We are NOT the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). All information shared between a client and our staff is completely confidential.***

We provide educational workshops, seminars, training to community groups, social service agencies, and others about taxpayer's rights and responsibilities.
