**YDOC :: AT A GLANCE School Information**

- Youth Day of Caring (YDOC) is school-based and open to area students in grades 7 – 12. **YDOC is held rain or shine!**
- While we love the enthusiasm of large groups, please understand that if more than 10-12 students from your school participate, they will be divided among multiple agencies and/or agency sites because the agencies are simply not large enough nor are the projects comprehensive enough to accommodate larger groups. We will make every effort to make the assignments at multiple locations within a reasonable geographic proximity, but please keep this mind for transportation logistics as well as recruitment of chaperones to accompany each group of students.
- Each participating school will arrange for their own bus/vehicle transportation for the students along with adult chaperone(s) to the various agencies.
- All volunteers must have a signed release form (to be provided by United Way) and take completed forms to your assigned agency/agencies (REQUIRED).
- Each participating student and adult chaperone will receive a LIVE UNITED t-shirt courtesy of our sponsor - NBT Bank. The t-shirts will be delivered to your school by a United Way representative prior to YDOC.
- Each agency will provide light refreshments for the students upon their arrival at the assigned agency.
- Photographers and/or members of the media may be visiting your assigned agency during YDOC. Please notify the United Way AND your agency coordinator of anyone from your school that cannot be photographed/recorded.
- Once the volunteer assignments are made, you will be contacted with the representative(s) from your assigned agency(ies). Please work with them for all details, location, directions, etc.
- At approximately noon, the school bus/vehicle from each respective school will pick up students from the assigned agency(ies) and transport them to the **Greater Scranton YMCA** for lunch from noon - 1 p.m.
